1921 - 1999

Rowland W. Hill age 77, of Caseville died Wednesday, March 31, at Hills and Dales Hospital, Cass City.

He was born August 6, 1921 in Sarnia, Ont. to the late John and Mildred (Gould) Hill. On October 17, 1951 he was united in marriage to Shirley Henry. She preceded him in death, May 21, 1986. Three years later, on June 17, 1989, he married Shirley A. Maxwell in Pontiac.

Mr. Hill graduated from Henry Ford Trade School, he then served his country during WW II in the 2nd Marine Division and the Korean War 1st Marine Division at the Chosin Reservoir. After his service time he was employed by Ford Motor Company for 38 1/2 years retiring in 1978 and moved to Caseville. While in Huron County he worked as a welding Engineer at Active Industries for a time and taught welding at Harbor Beach High School and also filled in at the Huron Skill Center, Bad Axe until 96 when he had to leave for health reasons.

He was a life member and past commander of the Edison Heights VFW Post #9507, was a member of the Caseville Eagles Club Aerie # 3690 and the Calvary Baptist Church, Caseville.

Surviving are his wife, Shirley; three sons, Harold Pellow and his wife, Marlee of St. Helen, Robert Hill and his wife,eresa of New Boston and James Hill of Lincoln Park; two daughters, Sharon Edward and her husband Jack, of Sterling Heights and Patricia March and her husband, Raymond of Ocala, FL; his grandchildren and great grandchildren; his sister, Phyllis Southerland of FL and his brother, Jim McIntyre of Clinton Twp.
