The Okaloosa Arts Alliance (OAA) would like to invite all Okaloosa County School students to participate in the 10th Annual OAA Okaloosa County School Poster Contest. The OAA wants to know what you consider "Summer Fun". It can be anything you can create on paper with markers, pencils, paint, pastels, charcoal, or crayons. There will be a 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winner for three elementary school students (K-4), for three middle school students (5-7), and for three high school students (8-12) in Okaloosa County. Each 1st place winner will receive a \$75 gift card, each 2nd place winner will receive a \$50 gift card and each 3rd place winner will receive a \$25 gift card. Additionally, the 1st place winners' artwork will be posted in the OAA newsletter and on the OAA website.

Any Okaloosa County School student can enter; entries can be submitted by an Okaloosa County School or by an individual student. The poster contest deadline is **May 17, 2019.** Please submit only one entry per student. Posters should be standard size (8 ½ x 11) for the contest and should include, the name of the artist, their grade, and the name of their school. Please mail your entries to Okaloosa Arts Alliance-Poster Contest, P.O. Box 4426, FWB, FL 32549 or drop off entries at the Young Philosopher's Society inside the Santa Rosa Mall (slide poster entry under door if closed- clearly label "OAA Poser Contest").

All poster contest entries will be on display on Sat, May 18th from 1-3pm at Young Philosophers Society; winners will be announced at the poster contest display and will include refreshments, arts activities and organizations providing summer youth art class and camp information.
