- Implementing an intramural sports program in schools across the district and ensuring schools are providing programs in the arts, as surfaced from the Listening & Learning Tours

  areas, social emotional learning, culturally responsive and sustaining education (CR-SE), and Habits
  of Mind (part of the New York State Integration Project Grant)
- Monitoring the progress of all schools in order to identify specific next steps and implement action plans to bring the schools to the next level
