

Ordinance No. 587

An ordinance in relation to the sale of water by the city of garnett, from the waterworks of said city, by contract, and to repeal part of section 1. of Ordinance No. 509, In relation to ~~repealing~~ amending Ordinance No. 464 and repealing Sec. 25 of said ordinance No. 464.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and board of Commissioners of the City of Garnett, Kansas:

Section 1. That consumers of water in the city of Garnett, who use more than 50,000. gallons per month may obtain water from the waterworks system of said city, by executing a contract therefor and at such price as may be agreed upon by the board of commissioners of said city.

Section 2. That all that part of Section One of Ordinances No. 509 relating to the sale of water by said city, by meter measure in quantities of 50,000. gallons ~~xxxxxxx~~ or more, per month, be and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the time required by law from its passage and its publication in *the weekly Review of said city*
