DESCRIPTION: This was the bow that turned Hoyt into a world class archery company. Great looking and performing re-curve. This old gal still shoots like a dream. Includes the authentic Hoyt stabilizers shown (See note below). Limbs are white but have the typical yellowing that comes with age. The limbs are a uniform color but may look more white in some of the pics (it's a camera thing). Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in good condition. A repair was made to a cracked upper tip and overlay (see pic on last page). No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. There are several small filled sight screw holes on the face of the riser (see pics on p. 4). A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. Decal is in excellent condition. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. This bow sold for \$130 in 1963, which translates to \$1144.00 in 2021 inflation adjusted dollars.
