Aloha Kakou,

As I write this, I am also preparing to head off to our annual Synod Assembly in Palm Desert, California. As I flip through the Assembly packet, I am not seeing anything earth-shaking happening. Grateful for that this year. We have had enough "earth-shaking" events the last few years, haven't we?

I have been reflecting upon the many words and phrases that I have used over the last few years – "radical uncertainty," "social acceleration," "complexity," and even "chaotic whizzing."

I think early on I was using in my sermons and elsewhere a phrase that I cannot quite recall – "The Three (or was it Four?) P's – Pandemic, Politics, and? I am drawing a blank. Does anyone remember what those three (or four?) P's were? I suspect they are buried deep in one or more of my sermons, but I haven't found them. If you remember, please, let me know!

Now, I have happened upon another – "permacrisis," which I mentioned in my latest Weekly Announcement missive last Wednesday. It was the 2022 Word of the Year for Collins Dictionary. A portmanteau of two words – "permanent" and "crisis." It refers to a sense that our difficulties and challenges are going to continue for a good long time. Not a fun word.

So, I think I am going to ponder one that has been floating around my brain for a bit, but that I have not mentioned much until recently – "resonance." It's a happier word. It means being moved, gripped, convicted by something/someone unexpected. There are "vibes," a sense of connection that is good, right, and beautiful.

Sort of like "resurrection." Another "re-" word, with joyful overtones. Yes, let us ponder resonance for a time, taking encouragement, hope and delight from it, so that, even then, in the midst of a permacrisis, we can find life, love, and creativity.
