

CONCLUSIONS / EVALUATION / PRESENTATION

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- Summarise findings, draw conclusions
- Thorough ability to write up results clearly and logically using a range of presentation methods
 - (Again well structured; exec summary, intro etc etc range of relevant + applicable presentation methods used to illustrate ideas, show trends etc)
- Effective evaluation and reflection on the investigation
 - (strengths + weaknesses and future research possibilities and directions)
- Complete explanation of how results relate to wider contexts.
 - (theoretical, locational, comparative.)
- Thorough understanding of ethical dimensions of research
 - (In human research you may interact with the public, your results may be seen by the public and you may make value judgements)
- Ability to write a coherent analysis of the findings in order to answer your question/hypotheses.
 - (Must relate back to introductory ideas and draw supported conclusions)
- Draw effectively on evidence and theory to make a well argued case
 - (backs up conclusions with specific facts/figures/results)
