1920 - 1996

Otto H. Lutat, 76 of Chandler Township near Elton, passed away Nov. 3 at Four Seasons Health Care Center, Bad Axe.

He was born Oct. 18, 1920 in Sebawaing, son of the late Walter and Ida (Merz) Lutat. On Oct. 26, 1985 he married Martha L. (Hirzke) Lenk in Deckerville.
