



**NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC  
PUBLIC HEARING  
AMENDMENT TO HISTORIC DISTRICT GUIDELINES - MURALS**

The Middleburg Town Council will hold a public hearing on Thursday, March 14, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. in the Town Hall Council Chambers, located at 10 W. Marshall Street, to consider an amendment to the Historic District Guidelines pertaining to murals. If approved, the following language would be added to the Appendix:

*It is the policy of the Historic District Review Committee to not approve murals. While mural art is widely considered one of the oldest methods of artistic expression, mural art has not historically been part of the Middleburg Historic District. Without historic precedents, the introduction of murals to the District would not serve the purpose of the Historic District regulations, which is to preserve the unique historical, architectural and cultural, and archaeological heritage of the Town and all significant historic and archaeological resources within the Town. As such, murals are not appropriate in the Middleburg Historic District.*

All interested citizens are invited to attend this public hearing to express their views.
