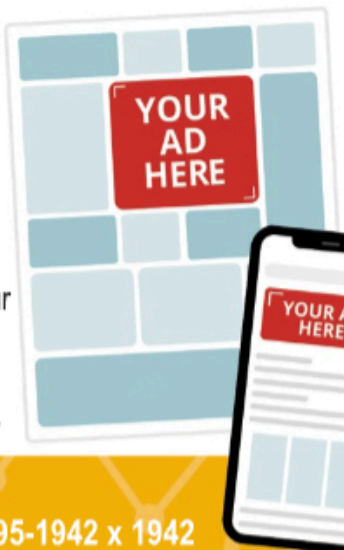

**Pastor's Reflection**

Last week, we looked at the Corporal Works of Mercy. This week, we'll examine the Spiritual Works of Mercy. While the Corporal Works focused on the physical needs of others, these will focus on the mental, emotional and spiritual needs we all have, and the importance of being supportive to others as a part of our call to love. These acts of love nurture the soul and when we perform them, we are acting as God's instruments in providing healing and spiritual strength. Just as with the Corporal Works, there are seven Spiritual Works of Mercy.

**Counsel the Doubtful.** Everyone questions their faith at times. When our faith is strong, we may have an opportunity to help others who are wavering, especially those who can no longer see God's providence and love in their lives. The best way to do this isn't by preaching to them, but just living our own faith with joy and hope.

**Instruct the Ignorant.** When we share the truths of the Gospel and of the Church, we can help others to understand better. Members of our parish who volunteer with religious education or OCIA are living this Work of Mercy.

**Admonish Sinners.** This one is tough because not everyone is open to being corrected. Again, the best way to live this isn't with words, but with the actions of love and faith in our own lives, especially towards those caught in sin.

**Comfort the Afflicted.** Everyone has been wounded in life. We all have hurts and difficulties. Despite this we can help others who are experiencing pain, sorrow or loneliness. We do with empathy, encouragement, and just our presence. Visits to the homebound, the sick and the sorrowing are especially important.

**Forgive Offenses.** Jesus repeatedly reminds us that we will be forgiven in as much as we forgive those who hurt us. I think this is one of the toughest teachings of our faith. When we forgive we are truly reflecting the love of Jesus, who from the cross asked God to forgive his executioners.

**Bear Wrongs Patiently.** This doesn't mean that we just let people do whatever they want to us. We do have a right to defend ourselves and seek redress when wronged. But we can do so with love and forgiveness. That's the best way to bear wrongs patiently.

**Pray for the Living and the Dead:** This is one all of us can do, no matter what our situation in life. I think it is especially important to pray for the dead, so that at their last moment they can experience the love you have for them as they enter into eternity.
