All Walk Trot



- 5. Sidepass to the left
- 6. Lope right lead over poles and between first set of poles and sidepass
- 7. When past the sidepass change leads to left lead
- 8. Jog a serpentine through the cones
- 9. Break to a walk and walk into box
- 10. Perform a 360 degree turn to the left
- 11. Walk out of box, over bridge and pole
- 12. Lope left lead to finish
