The Department of Arizona also awards the **Wilma Hoyal-Maxine Chilton Memorial Scholarship** to a second-year or upper division student in Political Science, Public Programs, or Special Education at Arizona State University, Northern Arizona University, or the University of Arizona.

DEPARTMENT OF ARIZONA EDUCATION AWARDS & SCHOLARSHIP RULES

All area of the National Organization's Education program should be emphasized and Units are encouraged to participate.

The Department winners of the *Children of Warriors National Presidents' Scholarship*, *The Non-Traditional Student Scholarship*, *The Spirit of Youth Scholarship*, and *The Junior Member Loyalty Scholarship* will each receive a \$25 cash award, and these awards will be included in the annual Department budget as a separate line item.

The department has established the Wilma Hoyal/Maxine Chilton Memorial Scholarship. There are three scholarships awarded annually; one to Arizona State University, one to The University of Arizona, and one to Northern Arizona University.

This scholarship is renewable provided the student meets the outlined criteria. Recipient must file an application through the American Legion Auxiliary Department office. Applications for this scholarship may be secured by the student through the University office or the American Legion Auxiliary.

Recipient must be enrolled as a second year or an upper-division student in Political Science, Public Programs, or Special Education.

Rules and requirements for these scholarships will be provided with the application form.
