Exhibition Dates: February 22, 2020 to April 18, 2020. (two floors: estimated capacity 90 artworks)

***Grand Gala Opening:** Saturday, February 22, 2020. 5-9pm. By request from the Anderson Arts Center, due to the large volume of expected guests, the participants and a guest are included by invitation only. The general membership of LMA will have a social gathering on February 23rd to see the art and the newly remodeled museum at their leisure during the hours of 1-4.

***ARTISTS SOCIAL GATHERING:** Sunday, February 23, 2020 1-4. If the weather outside is frightful do not come delightful.... come at your leisure at another time during the galleries open hours. Call your fellow artists and come together!

Delivery of artwork: Saturday, February 1, 2020 1-4pm

Dates for pickup of artwork: Saturday, April 25, 2020 1-4pm

Registration deadline: January 18, 2020 midnight. LMA has redesigned their application form to a single application process. No more separate form for Juried and for non-juried. We will have all forms look like the juried form where you apply and send in your jpegs.

Details: Only works that have been created within the last 3 years AND have not been previously exhibited in any other LMA Show or at the Anderson Arts Center will be considered.

Artists should pre-register with LMA on its website using the new application form. *The description needed in this form is for your own publicity and to enhance each exhibition especially when the exhibit has a THEME. It is there to describe how your work relates to the theme or to what your thought process was concerning this work on creating it. This helps to sell your work. One is required at least, but if you choose not to add the description to the rest of your works entered then you may lose this benefit of additional publicity for yourself. A reminder, bring your 8x10, heavy laminated bios to EACH exhibition drop-off.*

All framed artwork and 3D work have no size requirements. If it fits in the door, then you are alright! 2D work needs to be presented with D-rings or picture wire for hanging. Only works that are pre-registered will be accepted on drop-off dates. Artists may pre-register up to five (5) artworks each, but work may be subject to space availability by its order of registration. The later you register increases the likelihood your work will be edited from the show due to space restraints. The overflow date will be arranged the week of February 16th. Artists will be notified by email to pick up (if any) excess work. However, everyone will have at least one work in this exhibition.

Anderson Arts Center retains a 35% commission.
