

# CARL WILLIAM HUBEL

## 1928 - 1993

Carl William Hubel, 65 of Caseville, passed away suddenly on Friday, March 26 at Scheurer Hospital, Pigeon, of an apparent heart attack.

He was born on Feb. 7, 1928, son of Adva (Ayolte) Hubel and the late Frank C. Hubel. He was married to Leah John Switzer on Aug. 26, 1950 at St. Monica's Church in Detroit.
