Legislative Day schedule:

Time: 9:30 A.M. for Legislative Days (unless otherwise noted)

Place: House Office Building Cafeteria - Northeast corner across from Capitol Building

Agenda: 9:30 a.m. - 9:45 a.m. - “Orientation” to answer your questions
 9:45 a.m. - 12 noon - Meet with YOUR Legislators in their offices
 12 noon - 12:30 p.m. - Lunch Break – Meet in House Office Building Cafeteria
 12:30 p.m. - - Meet for Summary (as necessary)

Before going to the Capitol, call and make arrangements to meet with YOUR Senator and Representative. Call at least a week in advance to set up a personal meeting. If you need help or back-up for any meetings, call a member of the Board of Directors so we can make arrangements for someone to be there with you.

When you call your Legislator’s office, ask for the “scheduler”. They can tell you when your Legislator may be available. If your Legislator is not available for that day then ask for an appointment with the Aide who is in charge of the particular issue you want to talk about. You can call your Legislator out of session from the “Floor” (we will explain how during Orientation).

If you cannot attend “Legislative Day” set up an appointment anyway and call a member of the Legislative Committee or Board and we will go there for you (not in your name).

Please call to make your appointments as soon as possible.
