1. Choosing and cropping your photo reference – composition and size.
2. What to leave in and what to leave out – how much detail is enough.
3. Gridding method to lay out your drawing.
4. Underpainting with large shapes.
5. Working into the large shapes to create the illusion of detail.
6. Refining the painting – lost and found edges.

11:00 am – 1:00 pm Susan will do a demo on Lux Archival Sanded paper with a watercolor underpainting. You can paint along during this or just watch. She will also have a slide show of examples of complicated subjects. Susan will record the demo.

1:00 – 1:45 pm Break for lunch and/or start your painting

1:45 – 3:45 pm Interactive studio time. Paint from Susan's photo reference or your own.

3:45 – 4:00 pm Final questions and 'show and tell'.

Born in Chicago, Illinois, **Susan Kuznitsky** was predisposed towards art from an early age. After graduating from high school, Susan further honed her skills at the American Academy of Art in Chicago. It was also around this time that she fell in love with the Impressionists while exploring the Art Institute in downtown Chicago during her time at the academy. Particularly inspired by pastels of that era, Susan made a life-altering decision to move to Woodstock, New York, to learn from Master Artist Albert Handell, who fortunately needed a studio assistant around the same time. Under his stewardship, Susan developed a unique teaching style that remains influential till today. Today, Susan professionally pursues her passion for art, teaching in-person classes and workshops, locally, internationally, and online.
