Biography

Craig Routzahn, age 68, passed away unexpectedly September 16th. Craig was born on September 18, 1955 to the late Raymond and Ruth (Siewert) Routzahn in Madison Heights. After graduation from Specs Howard School of Broadcasting in 1975 Craig moved to the thumb to start his career in radio. Craig Routzahn joined the WLEW staff September 15, 1975 as a mid-morning disc jockey. During his 46 years with WLEW Craig became a respected, and often revered, member of the community, from Law Enforcement, City and Township Officials, and those at the county and state levels well. Craig Routzahn was passionate and dedicated to his

craft. Craig was persistent about presenting both sides of the story as the voice of the News for Michigan's thumb.
