EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY POSTING

Position: Certified Water Plant **AND** Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator.

The City of Willard, Ohio is accepting applications for a combination, certified, Water Treatment and Wastewater Treatment Plant Operator. The desired candidate will possess current Water Treatment and Wastewater Treatment Operator's certifications. The successful applicant will possess a current Water Treatment Operator's certification, as a minimum, and submit evidence of same with the application. If the successful applicant holds only the Water Treatment certificate, it is understood, that as a condition of continued employment, within one year of the date of hire, the applicant must obtain a Wastewater Treatment Operator's Certification.

In addition to the credential requirements, the successful applicant must demonstrate enthusiasm, the flexibility necessary to work with multiple supervisors, an understanding that employment may require shift work, holidays and weekends, a commitment to teamwork, Safety, and a firm understanding of the professionalism required to participate in our City workforce.

Summary of qualifications: Must possess a valid State of Ohio driver's license and the ability to obtain an Ohio Commercial Driver's License (CDL) within six months of date of hire; must be a high school graduate or equivalent, with evidence provided with the application; must be a U.S. citizen and reside in Huron or any of the abutting Counties, within six months of date of hire; must pass a background investigation, post offer drug screen, medical physical, and physical agility test.
