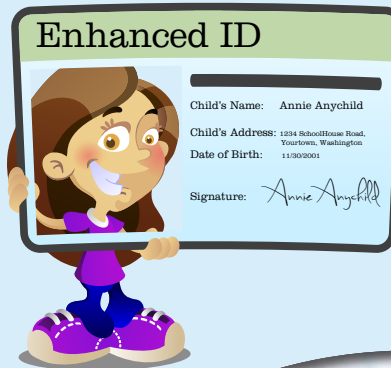

\$ Reimbursement Voucher

Step 1: Before You Go Checklist

Make sure you have all the necessary documents for your child before you arrive at the Department of Licensing!

A. Bring the child's original or certified copy of his/her state issued birth certificate which establishes identity and U.S. citizenship. A hospital birth certificate or photocopy is not acceptable by the Department of Licensing.



B. Provide the child's Social Security Number.



C. Establish state residency by bringing parent/guardian's driver's license with current physical address, or home utility bill with parent's name and physical address.



D. Pay fee—Enhanced Identification Cards cost \$72.00 (Fee will be reimbursed at the Boys & Girls Clubs of Skagit County).



A custodial parent or legal guardian must sign permission for the child to obtain an EID and present acceptable proof of his/her relationship with the child and an acceptable document proving his/her identity. Guardian must bring certified court order establishing legal guardianship of the child. Guardian must also bring his/her own driver's license or state ID.

How to Obtain an Enhanced ID for Your Child!

A Washington State Enhanced Identification (EID) card from the Washington State Department of Licensing is a smart choice for any parent who wants faster United States border crossing, a reliable proof of identity for their child, and a way to help protect their child from becoming a victim of identity theft. Best of all, through the **Keeping IDentities Safe[®] for KIDS** program, parents can obtain reimbursement for the cost of an Enhanced ID card for their child. Reimbursement is through the Skagit County Boys & Girls Clubs after they purchase it from the Washington State Department of Licensing.

Step 2:

Go to the Dept. of Licensing

If you do not Possess your Child's Birth Certificate:

To obtain a certified copy of your child's birth certificate, go to www.skagitcounty.net/Departments/HealthVitalStatistics. You may also contact the Skagit County Health & Human Services Section directly by calling (360) 419-3420. If your child was born in another state, check that state's Department of Vital Records website.
