CLASS DESCRIPTIONS

Leadline: Open to beginner riders age 10 and under. To be led by an adult.

Walk Trot: Open to riders 12 and under who have not shown at the canter.

Beginner Equitation: Open to riders of any age beyond the walk trot level looking to transition into short/long stirrup. Canter may be individual or in small group, at judge's discretion. One class in division must be a ground pole course – trotting not penalized.

Short/Long Stirrup: To be divided by Short and Long if entries permit. Short: Open to riders 12 and *under*. Fences not to exceed 18". Riders may not show in any other division except Pleasures, Long: Open to riders 13 and over who have never competed in classes with fences over 2'. Fences not to exceed 18". Riders may not show in any division other than Pleasure and classes where fence heights do not exceed 2'.

Pleasure Division: Classes open to all horses and ponies. To be shown at walk, trot and canter in both directions. Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness. Martingales not permitted.

Pre-Child/Adult Equitation: Open to Junior riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 2'3" in a recognized show. Riders may show horses or ponies. Fences 2', no combinations. Simple changes will not be penalized.

Baby Green Hunters Open to any horse in their first or second year of showing who has never shown higher than 2'6" in said first or 2nd year, Horses that enter this division may not enter any classes where fence heights exceed 2'6". No rider restrictions.

Children's Hunter Pony Open to all ponies ridden by juniors. All ponies, 12.2 hands and under to jump 2'. Medium ponies, over 12.2 but not exceeding 13.2 to jump 2'3". Large Ponies, over 13.2 but not to exceed 14.2 to jump 2'6". Judged on manners, performance, suitability and soundness.

Novice Hunter: Riders must be eligible for novice adult or novice junior equitation as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders who enter this division at a given show may not enter any other class at that show in which fence height exceeds 2'6. Fences 2', no combinations.

Junior/Amateur Hunter: Open to all except professional riders. No horse restrictions. Horse/rider combinations that enter this division at a given show may not enter any other class at the show in which fence height exceeds 2'6". No combinations.

Children's Equitation: Open to junior riders who have never competed in fences over 2'6" in a recognized show. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'6" with at least one change of direction. No combinations.

Low Hunters: Open to all horses and ponies and riders with no age limitations. To be judged on manners, suitability, and soundness. Fences not to exceed 2'6"

Adult Hunter: Open to horses ridden by riders 18 years and older. Fences not to exceed 3'. Judged on manners, performance, suitability, and soundness.

Adult Equitation: Open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older. Fences not to exceed 2'6"

Modified Junior Equitation: Open to junior riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 3' in a recognized show. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'9" with at least one change of direction. Combinations optional.

Junior Equitation: Open to all junior riders who are not eligible for Pre-Children's or Children's Equitation. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 3' with at least one change of direction. Combinations optional.

Open Working/Junior Hunter: Fences to be 3' to 3'3". No restrictions on age or status of rider. Judged on manners, suitability, and soundness.

WNEPHA Short/Long Stirrup Medal: Open to riders who are eligible for short/long stirrup respectively. A course of at least 8 fences not to exceed 18". No combinations, no oxers.

WNEPHA Pre-Child / Adult Medal: To be shown over a course of at least 8 fences at a height of 2'. No combinations.

WNEPHA Children's Equitation Medal: Open to junior members who are eligible for Children's Equitation. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of at least 8 fences at a height of 2'6" with at least one change of direction.

WNEPHA Adult Medal: Open to adult members of the WNEPHA. Shown over a course of 8 fences, not to exceed 2'9", with at least one change in direction.

WNEPHA Modified Junior Equitation Medal: Open to riders who are eligible for Modified junior Equitation. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of at least 8 fences, with at least one change of direction, fence height not to exceed 2'9". Combinations optional

WNEPHA Junior Equitation Medal: Open to all junior members of the WNEPHA who are eligible for Junior Equitation. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be shown over a course of at least 8 fences at a height of 3', with at least one change in direction. Combinations optional.

2. Each exhibitor or trainer must fill out and sign an official entry blank before numbers will be issued.
3. All mounted riders must wear an ASTM/SEI approved helmet at all times.
4. Show committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, or split any classes if entries warrant.
5. The officials listed have been invited to officiate. Show management reserves the right to make adjustments if circumstances require.
6. All dogs must be on a leash at all times.
7. Bellwether/Sebring Stables is a smoke-free facility.
8. NEHC Class Specifications can be read in the current NEHC Rulebook
9. **MASKS ARE REQUIRED WHEN APPROACHING THE SECRETARY BOOTH, IN GATE, OR SHOW MANAGEMENT.**
10. Please practice social distancing and limit the number of spectators for each rider.
11. When your classes are complete please leave the show grounds to limit the number of people on the property at any given time.
12. Covid protocols will be enforced by show management.
13. Food will not be available. Please plan accordingly. Bottled water will be available for purchase at the secretary's booth.
