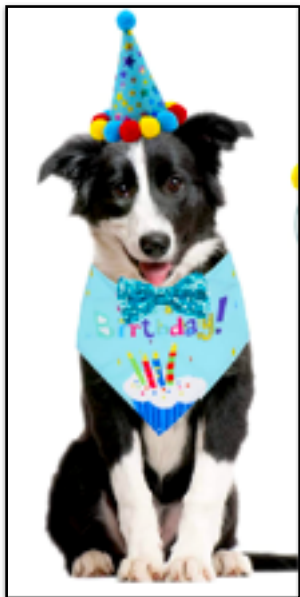

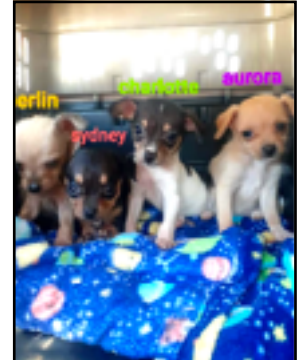


Daphne, "Dream Team Angels". Much neglected senior dog. She was adopted but sadly passed shortly afterwards. She was so loved in her last days.

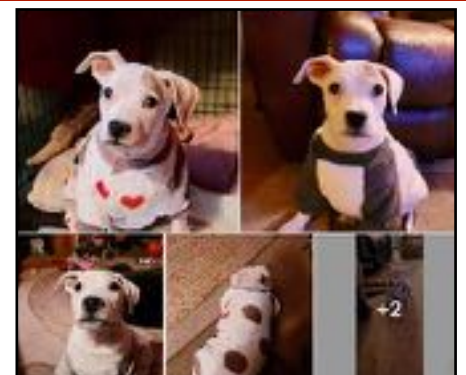
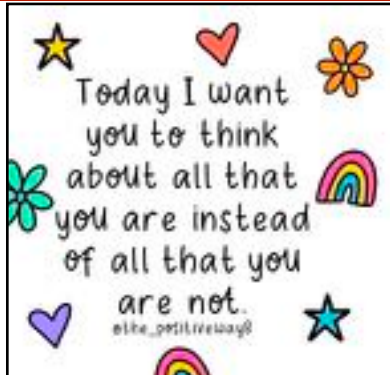


Bugsy! Dumped by a breeder at the shelter. We were able to help "Dream Team Angles" a little with his care.
