Mr. Francis A. Hund, 96, of Ubly, died Wednesday, Dec. 23, 2009 at Courtney Manor in Bad Axe after a lengthy illness.

He was a past member of the Ubly Lions Club and the Ubly Community Club. Francis also served on the Ubly Board of Education for a number of years. He served on the committee to raise funds to construct Huron Memorial Hospital in Bad Axe and served on the Hospital Board of Incorporators for a number of years. He continues as an honorary member of the Board of Incorporators. Francis also helped raise funds for the Ubly Senior Center in Ubly, where a room is named for him.

In 2002, Francis established the Francis and Opal Hund Scholarship for an Ubly High School graduate. He was very proud of this contribution to the Ubly Community.

Francis was a lifelong member of St. John the Evangelist Catholic Church in Ubly.

Francis is survived by his children, Ferris S. Hund and his wife, Patricia, of Shelby Township, Robert F. Hund and his wife, Shirley, of Sterling Heights, Joan M. Bieniek and her husband, Ron, of Lexington, Janet M. Ericson and her husband, Charles, of Fort Myers, Fla., Mary Jane Sweeney and her husband, Kenneth, of Ubly, James A. Hund and his wife, Mary Ellen, of Hastings; and daughter-in-law, Maureen Hund Scully of Weeki Wachee, Fla. He is also survived by 24 grandchildren; 42 great-grandchildren; and one great-great-grandson. He is also survived by his brother, Philip (Lillian) Hund of Rochester.
