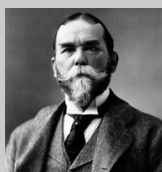


CFA 2nd Annual Dancing with the Lake Sunapee Stars

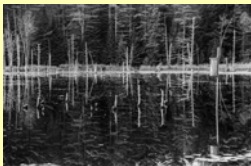
