Title Tip: What Title Needs - Gathering Final Information From Sellers

When it comes to purchasing or selling a property, title companies play a crucial role in the transfer of ownership. Below is a list of information that needs to be gathered from sellers to ensure a smooth and successful transaction.

STATEMENT OF INFORMATION

Was a Statement of Identification/ID Affidavit requested by the title officer? If so, and if it was not delivered to your Escrow Officer prior to the signing appointment, please complete and return it immediately. This is a crucial piece of documentation, and the transaction cannot close without it being provided.

VESTING NAMES ON TITLE

Please confirm the vested name(s) on title match the identification you will present at time of signing for the Notary. A discrepancy may require documents to be re-drawn and cause delays.

ENTITY DOCUMENTS

If the sale is on behalf of a Corporation, Trust or LLC the entity documents must be submitted for review by the title department in order for the sale to be approved to close and be insured. For any questions, please feel free to reach out to me or your title officer today!
