

ORDINANCE 85- 7
ORDINANCE REGULATING HEADSTONES IN THE MCKINNEY
ADDITION TO CHAPIN CEMETERY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAPIN, MORGAN COUNTY, ILLINOIS

SECTION 1. That all headstones placed in the McKinney Addition to Chapin Cemetery, lots 176 through 375, shall be placed so that the tops of such headstones are level with the ground; further, that the minimum size of such headstones be 8 inches by 12 inches plus 4 inches of border.

SECTION 2. Total foundation plus border shall not be less than 12 inches deep, plus not less than 2 six-inch holes drilled or dug — overall depth 36 inches and filled with concrete for support.

SECTION 3. Formula for foundations shall be made of not less than four (4) parts gravel and sand to one (1) part cement.

SECTION 4. That the placing of cut flowers, plastic flowers and other decorations shall be allowed on said lots for 10 days prior to and 10 days following these days: Easter, Memorial Day, Mother's Day and Father's Day. The Village is hereby authorized to remove such articles except during those periods provided above.

SECTION 5. That the planting of any tree, shrub or other plant in lots 176 through 375 of the McKinney Addition of the Village Cemetery, except as done by authorized Village personnel, shall be unlawful. The Village is hereby authorized to remove any such plant.

SECTION 6. Penalties. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined ten dollars (\$10.00) for each offense. In the case of a violation of Sections 1-3 of this Ordinance, the Village shall act to make the violating headstone comply with said Sections 1-3, and charge the costs of such action to the person responsible for said violation. If it is impossible or impractical to make such headstone conform to this Ordinance, then such headstone shall be removed, and costs of removal shall be charged to the person responsible for said violation.

ORDINANCE 28-V
ORDINANCE REGULATING HEADSTOCKS IN THE WILKINSON
ADDITION TO CHAIRS IN THE WILKINSON

AS ORDERED BY THE REGIMENT AND BOARD OF TOWNERS OF THE VILLAGE OF CHAIRS, WILKINSON COUNTY, GEORGIA

SECTION 1. That all headstocks placed in the Wilkinson Addition to Chairs Cemetery, Georgia, shall be placed so that the top of such headstones are level with the ground surface, and the minimum size of such headstones be 2 inches by 18 inches and 4 inches of height.

SECTION 2. Total foundation pits shall not be less than 18 inches deep, plus not less than 3 inches holes drilled in the overall length 38 inches and filled with concrete for support.

SECTION 3. Foundations for headstones shall be made of not less than four (4) parts gravel and sand to one (1) part cement.

SECTION 4. That the placing of any headstone or other obelisk, flower and other decorations shall be allowed on any lot for 10 days prior to and 10 days following these days: Easter, Memorial Day, Veterans Day and Independence Day. The Village is hereby authorized to remove such articles except during these periods provided above.

SECTION 5. That the placing of any tree, shrub or other plant in lot 178 through 278 of the Wilkinson Addition to the Chairs Cemetery, except as done by authorized Village personnel, shall be unlawful. The Village is hereby authorized to remove any such plant.

SECTION 6. Penalties. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined ten dollars (\$10.00) for each offense. In the case of a violation of Sections 1-5 of this Ordinance, the Village shall act to make the violating headstone comply with said Sections 1-5 and charge the costs of such action to the person responsible for said violation. If it is impossible or impractical to make such headstone conform to this Ordinance, then such headstones shall be removed, and costs of removal shall be charged to the person responsible for said violation.
