FAIR CAMPGROUND RULES

PLEASE BE A GOOD NEIGHBOR

- Campers are required to check in at the fair office before entering the campgrounds.
- All campers are required to purchase four-day admission wristbands or all access wristbands and wear them Thursday - Sunday.
- You must be 18 to rent a campsite.
- All full hook-up sites are for trailers only.
- Switching of campsites is prohibited.
- Running extension cords between campsites is prohibited.
- Garbage must be bagged and put in the dumpster.
- No open fires are allowed in the campgrounds area.
- Each campsite is limited to one (1) vehicle and one (1) RV.
- Your vehicle is only permitted in the campground to which you were assigned.
- Vehicles which are illegally parked will be towed at the owner's expense.
- The speed limit is 5 MPH.
- Livestock trailers belonging to campers must be parked in the North-end of dirt parking lot.
- No ATV's, golf carts, bikes, skateboards, roller blades etc. are allowed. Contact the Fair Office for a placard, if for medical reasons you require use of an electric wheelchair or mobility scooter.
- One pet is allowed per campsite. Pets must always be on a leash or confined. Only service animals wearing service vests are allowed in the Fairgrounds. Any pet not leashed or confined, or which creates excessive noise or disturbance, is subject to removal from the fairgrounds.
- Obscenities, excessive noise, or other excessive activities will not be tolerated and may result in the offending parties being removed from the campground.
