**TENEBRAE** - Deepen Your Spiritual Journey Through Holy Week by Attending Tenebrae. All are invited to attend the Tenebrae at St. Mary's Church, in Port Jervis at 50 Ball Street. The celebrations will be at 10 AM on Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday, April 18, 19 and 20. **About the Tenebrae:** The word Tenebrae can be translated to "darkness" or "shadows" Centered around the Matins, (Holy Hours) scriptural readings and Lauds of the last three days of Holy Week. Participants will be singing the chants in English of responsorial psalms and hearing the readings of the day. The traditions regarding this service go back at least to the ninth century. Originally celebrated after midnight, the candles were extinguished until only the "Christ Candle" remained. The participants would leave the church in darkness meditating on Christ's betrayal, agony and death.
