- Structure fire on Douglas Hill road 3/19?? Some difficulty with water supply. Structure fully involved by the time the first units arrived on scene. Need to be aware of electrical service entering the house.
- Reminder: we don't respond to medical calls in Standish.
- Standish ladder currently out of service.
- Bring gear and radios to April meeting.
- Discussion on high visibility t-shirts.
- Keith to get quote on class B uniforms.

East Baldwin

- Need to setup work party. Need to get bathroom cleaned up.
- Large hole in pavement needs to be tended to.
- New tank truck not leaving Florida till July 12th. Pump testing at Attleboro, MA. Then up to Maine for lettering etc..

- Tank 2 had frozen intake for tank fill.
- Need punch list for building improvement.
