The Class Selections below include ALL CLASSES OFFERED FOR EACH AGE GROUP/LEVEL. **If you desire an individual class for your student (i.e., a once-a-week ballet, acrobatics, tap class) or if you prefer not to participate in one or more of the classes offered for your child's level, please contact the director so that we can best meet your needs.** We understand that financial and time constraints, and individual preferences, are different for each family and student and are happy to help you find the perfect fit for your student.

_____ Preschool Dance: creative movement/pre-ballet for children ages 3-4 who are beginning their first year of dance. Classes are once a week for forty-five minutes.

Tuition: 10 Payments of \$60/2 Semester Payments of \$300/1 Yearly Payment of \$600

Recital Fee: \$150

Costume Fee: \$100 (Dancers will have ONE Dance in our Spring Performance)

Class Days/Times Available: Wednesdays 4:30-5:15 pm (Morning or Weekend classes available upon request—if interested please inquire with Director)

_____ Primary Dance: creative movement/pre-ballet and introduction to acrobatics for children aged 4 and taking their second year of dance, or age 5 and beginning their first year of dance. Classes are once a week for one hour.

Tuition: 10 Payments of \$80/2 Semester Payments of \$400/1 Yearly Payment of \$800 Recital Fee: \$150

Costume Fee: \$100 (Dancers will have ONE Dance in our Spring Performance)

Class Days/Times Available: Thursdays 4:30-5:30 pm (Morning or Weekend classes available upon request—if interested please inquire with Director)

_____ Advanced Primary Dance: beginner ballet and acrobatics for children in kindergarten who have completed at least one year of dance, or who are in first grade and beginning their first year of dance. Classes are once a week for an hour and fifteen minutes.

Tuition: 10 Payments of \$100/2 Semester Payments of \$500/1 Yearly Payment of \$1000 Recital Fee: \$150

Costume Fee: \$200 (Dancers will have TWO dances in our Spring Performance)

Class Days/Times Available: Tuesdays 4:30-5:45 pm

_____ Level I Dance: ballet, acrobatics, and intro to tap for children in first grade who have completed at least one year of dance, or who are in second grade and beginning their first year of dance. Classes are once a week for two hours of instruction.

Tuition: 10 Payments of \$125/2 Semester Payments of \$625/1 Yearly Payment of \$1,250 Recital Fee: \$150

Costume Fee: \$200 (Dancers will have TWO dances in our Spring Performance)

Class Days/Times Available: Wednesdays 4:30-6:30 pm

_____ Level II Dance: ballet, acrobatics, tap, intro to jazz/modern dance for children in second grade who have completed at least one year of dance, or who are in third grade and beginning their first year of dance. Classes are twice a week, or dancers may take one or two of the classes offered (i.e., ballet and acro/once-a-week classes). Each class is between thirty minutes to an hour, averaging one and half to two hours of instruction per day.

Tuition: 10 Payments of \$150/2 Semester Payments of \$750/1 Yearly Payment of \$1,500

Recital Fee: \$150

Costume Fee: **\$100 per costume**, maximum of four costumes (ballet, tap, acro, jazz/modern)

Class Days/Times Available: Mondays 4:30-5:30 pm (Tap and Jazz); Thursdays 4:30-5:30 (Ballet) and 5:30-6:15 (Acrobatics)

_____ **Apprentice Company Member Request for Level II.** Level II Students may apply for Apprentice Membership in Bluebirds Ballet Company. Apprentice Company meets every other week on either Fridays or Saturdays.

Apprentice Company Dues: 10 Payments of \$25/2 Semester Payments of \$125/1 Yearly Payment of \$250. NO ADDITIONAL COSTUME OR RECITAL FEES.

_____ Level III Dance: ballet, acrobatics, tap, jazz and/or modern dance for children in third grade who have completed at least one year of dance, or who are in fourth grade and up and beginning their first year of dance. Classes are twice a week, or dancers may take one or two of the classes offered (i.e., ballet

and acro/once-a-week classes). Each class is between thirty minutes to an hour and fifteen minutes, averaging one and half to two hours of instruction per day.

Tuition: 10 Payments of \$175/2 Semester Payments of \$875/1 Yearly Payment of \$1,750

Recital Fee: \$150

Costume Fee: **\$100 per costume**, maximum of four costumes (ballet, tap, acro, jazz/modern)

Class Days/Times Available: Tuesdays 4:30-5:45 pm (Ballet), 5:45-6:20 pm (Jazz), and 6:20-7 pm (Modern); Thursdays 6:15-7:00 pm (Acrobatics) and 7:00-7:30 (Tap)

Apprentice Company Member Request for Level III. Level III Students may apply for Apprentice Membership in Bluebirds Ballet Company. Apprentice Company meets every other week on either Fridays or Saturdays.

Apprentice Company Dues: 10 Payments of \$25/2 Semester Payments of \$125/1 Yearly Payment of \$250. NO ADDITIONAL COSTUME OR RECITAL FEES.

____ Level IV Dance: ballet, pre-pointe, tap, acrobatics, jazz and/or modern for dancers who have completed Level III Dance. Classes are twice a week Dancers taking all classes come two to three times per week. Each class is thirty minutes to an hour and fifteen minutes, with instruction of up to two and hours and fifteen minutes per day.

Tuition: 10 payments of \$200/2 Semester Payments of \$1000/1 yearly Payment of \$2000

Recital Fee: \$150

Costume Fee: **\$100 per costume**, maximum of five costumes (ballet, tap, jazz, acro, modern)

Class Days/Times Available: Tuesdays 4:30-5:45 pm (Ballet), 5:45-6:20 pm (Jazz), and 6:20-7 pm (Modern); Thursdays 5:30-6:15 pm (Pre-Pointe), 6:15-7:00 pm (Acrobatics) and 7:00-7:30 (Tap)

Junior Company Membership Request for Level IV. Level IV Dancers may apply for Junior Membership in Bluebirds Ballet Company. Junior Company meets every week on either Fridays or Saturdays.

Junior Company Dues: 10 Payments of \$40/2 Semester Payments of \$200/1 Yearly Payment of \$400. NO ADDITIONAL COSTUME OR RECITAL FEE

____ Level V Dance: ballet, pre-pointe, tap, acrobatics, jazz and/or modern for dancers who have completed Level IV Dance. Dancers taking all classes come three to four times per week. Each class is thirty minutes to an hour and thirty minutes, with instruction of up to two and half hours per day.

Tuition: 10 payments of \$225/2 Semester Payments of \$1,125/1 yearly Payment of \$2,250

Recital Fee: \$150

Costume Fee: **\$125 per costume**, maximum of five costumes (ballet, tap, jazz, acro, modern)

Class Days/Times Available: Mondays 5:30-6:15 pm (Tap) and 6:15-7:45 pm (Ballet); Thursdays 5:30-6:30 pm (Pre-Pointe) and 6:30-7:15 pm (Jazz); Fridays 4:30-5:45 pm (Acrobatics) and 5:45-6:45 pm (Modern)

Junior Company Membership Request for Level V. Level V Dancers may apply for Junior Membership in Bluebirds Ballet Company. Junior Company meets every week on either Fridays or Saturdays.

Junior Company Dues: 10 Payments of \$40/2 Semester Payments of \$200/1 Yearly Payment of \$400. NO ADDITIONAL COSTUME OR RECITAL FEE

_____ Level VI Dance: ballet, pointe, tap, acrobatics, Pilates/conditioning, jazz and/or modern for dancers who have completed Level V Dance and who are in grades six through eight. Dancers taking all classes come four to five times per week. Each class is forty-five minutes to an hour and forty-five minutes, with instruction up to three hours per day.

Tuition: 10 payments of \$250/2 Semester Payments of \$1,250/1 yearly payment of \$2,500

Recital Fee: \$150

Costume Fee: **\$125 per costume**, maximum of five costumes (ballet, tap, jazz, acro, modern)

Class Days/Times Available: Mondays 4:30-6:15 pm (Ballet), 6:15-7 pm (Tap) and 7-7:45 pm (Pilates/Conditioning); Tuesdays 5:45-7:15 pm (Ballet/Pointe) and 7:15-8:15 pm (Modern); Wednesdays 5:15-6:15 pm (Beginner Pointe), 6:15-7:15 pm (Jazz), and 7:15-8:15 (Intermediate to Advanced Pointe); Thursdays 7:15-8:30 pm (Advanced Pointe/Variations/Repertoire); Fridays 4:30-5:45 pm (Acrobatics) and 5:45-6:45 pm (Lyrical/Contemporary)

*Dancers dancing *en pointe* must take at least three ballet classes per week.

_____ **Senior Company Membership Request for Level VI.** Level VI Dancers may apply for Senior Membership in Bluebirds Ballet Academy. Senior Company meets every week on either Fridays or Saturdays.

Senior Company Dues: 10 Payments of \$40/2 Semester Payments of \$200/1 Yearly Payment of \$400. NO ADDITIONAL COSTUME OR RECITAL FEE

_____ Level VII Dance: ballet, pointe, tap, acrobatics, Pilates/conditioning, jazz and/or modern for dancers who have completed Level VI Dance and are in high school. Dancers taking all classes come four to five times per week. Each class is forty-five minutes to an hour and forty-five minutes, with instruction up to three hours per day.

Tuition: 10 payments of \$250/2 Semester Payments of \$1,250/1 yearly payment of \$2,500

Recital Fee: \$150

Costume Fee: **\$125 per costume** maximum of five costumes (ballet, tap, jazz, acro, modern)

Class Days/Times Available: Mondays 4:30-6:15 pm (Ballet), 6:15-7 pm (Tap) and 7-7:45 pm (Pilates/Conditioning); Tuesdays 5:45-7:15 pm (Ballet/Pointe) and 7:15-8:15 pm (Modern); Wednesdays 5:15-6:15 pm (Beginner Pointe), 6:15-7:15 pm (Jazz), and 7:15-8:15 (Intermediate to Advanced Pointe); Thursdays 7:15-8:30 pm (Advanced Pointe/Variations/Repertoire); Fridays 4:30-5:45 pm (Acrobatics) and 5:45-6:45 pm (Lyrical/Contemporary)

_____ **Senior Company Soloist Membership Request for Level VII.** Level VII Dancers may apply for Senior Soloist Membership in Bluebirds Ballet Academy. Senior Company meets every week on Fridays or Saturdays.

Senior Company Soloist Dues: 10 Payments of \$40/2 Semester Payments of \$200/1 Yearly Payment of \$400. NO ADDITIONAL COSTUME OR RECITAL FEE
