DESCRIPTION: RARE Zebrawood BP Stallion (most were made from Bubinga). The Stallion model was just above the Javelina and just below the Mustang model in quality and price. Green face limbs; crimson back limbs. This one has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No drilled holes. No chips, dings or cracks. The only real flaw are the stress lines on the face of the bow toward the top of the riser. These were cleaned and filled with Loctite, but are readily visible (see pics). A few scratches and scuffs here and there. Decal are in great shape. Overall, this is a really nice bow for its age.
