**“THE HOUSE OF LOVE”**  
*‘Welcome to a class in LOVE’*

Ephesians 3:14-19 “To know the love of Christ.”

I John is concerned with the *foundational love component* of Christian living.  
The need to establish a *Love Identity in the church*.

We all are a community-in-progress *in stages of development in the life of love*.  
We are here to be formed over our lifetimes into a community of the *beloved of God*.  
God is unendingly patient with us, but often we are not very patient with one another.

We can and need to understand ourselves in a *love language*. **THINK LOVE!**

Belief and behavior are essential, but the defining mark of a Christian is one thing- *relationship!*  
Godly love relationships.

*Whoever heard of a class on love?*

Love is the highest and most complete expression of God’s revelation:

**GOD IS LOVE!** I John 4:16.

Love is also the highest and most complete expression of the human person:

“If we love one another... his love is perfected in us.” I John 4:16.

“When to love is now, where to love is here, and how to be loved is by loving others.”

*Let us have a class in LOVE.*

Think of any issue in your life: *Think God, think Love, think the will of God in that issue.*

“God loves you, God cares for you, God will speak to you.”

What is *God’s glorification*? He loves you!

The test in this “class of love” is:

- How much does God love you?
- How much do you love God?
- How much do you love each other?

We could ask “Oh..., how much do you love?”
