## NOTICE TO ALBERTA APPLICATORS

Alberta Environment and Parks is working closely with Lakeland College in light of the COVID-19 pandemic. As a result of many conferences and meetings being cancelled, we wish to provide opportunities to applicators to continue to obtain Recertification Credits to renew their Alberta Pesticide Certificates. **Until further notice, there will be no restriction on the number of archive credits an applicator can obtain** (i.e. archived credits will be considered the same as live credits). As always, a maximum of 10 credits are allowed to be accepted for recertification during one calendar year.

Professional Development Solutions, which is an online webinar company based in Alberta, has decided to add two more live weeks to their schedule this spring. All webinars during these two additional weeks will be "ALL CLASSES" which means regardless of your type of license or the amount of licenses, you will receive credits. ## PESTICIDE APPLICATOR CERTIFICATE OF QUALIFICATION For Geoff Thompson

All certificates that expire between March 25, 2019 to March 30, 2021 will be extended to March 31, 2021.

Should those who expire during this time wish to recertify utilizing recertification credits, they are encouraged to do so. When the time comes that it is safe to offer exams, applicators will be contacted by Lakeland College to resume recertification by examination earlier if permitted.
