

MINUTES
JUNE 16, 2022

The Walker Art Committee met on Thursday, June 16, 2022 at 4:00 p.m. in the art storeroom of the Garnett Public Library with the following present: Wanda Taylor, Nancy Foltz, Tami Hiestand, Denise Scheibmeir and Joyce Martin. Jenelle Klehammer attended by phone. Absent: Marcia Mader.

MINUTES

A motion was made by Nancy, seconded by Tami to approve the minutes of April 21, 2022 as printed. The motion was unanimously approved.

COMMUNICATIONS

A letter from Janay Blome, High School Counselor, was read thanking this committee for participating in the high school scholarship program. Her letter stated that \$88,000 was contributed to graduates of the class of 2022 by local organizations and individuals.

TREASURER'S REPORT

Wanda read the report as follows: Beginning balance as of May 1, 2022 was \$3,185.25. There was one expenditure of \$50 for our square fair booth. Closing balance as of May 31, 2022 is \$3,135.25. The report was approved as read.

CURATOR'S REPORT

Jenelle said that she would defer to the committee as to what we should do with the picture entitled "SUNSET" as gifted to the Garnett City Art Collection by Scott Rogers. A motion was made by Wanda, seconded by Nancy to decline this gift. The motion was unanimously approved. Wanda will discuss this with Librarian Andrea Sobba to determine if Scott wants the picture back.

Jenelle said that we need to make plans for the "At The Walker" event that will be held in November. She asked that this item be listed on the July meeting agenda.

OLD BUSINESS

Discussion was held on the square fair "I love you card" booth. Those committee members who worked at the booth suggested the following: that the booth should be in the shade, needs to be advertised more, needs to be part of the BPW advertising and have a banner that identifies who we are. Denise had the markers and crayons that were used at the booth. It was agreed that glitter should not be used or at least controlled better.

Members who attended the Van Gogh Exhibit showed pictures they took. They agreed that this was a very interesting and enjoyable trip.

Nancy reported that she has put pictures of the square fair booth on our facebook page.

NEW BUSINESS

Wanda showed a SEIKO clock that was given to her. She would like to donate this to the Garnett City Art Collection. The clock has chimes that plays seasonal music. It was suggested that we consider having a “timepiece” exhibit in the future.

GALLERY DISPLAYS

Questions were asked as to why there was no senior exhibit as planned for May and June. Jenelle said that the art teacher asked her senior art students and nobody wanted to participate. Another factor was that there were very few senior students in the class that were really interested in art. Hopefully that will change in the new school year. Jenelle will invite Elizabeth to attend our July meeting so we can ask questions as to what she would like for us to do to help her program and to make plans for the new school year.

Other planned exhibits were discussed. Nancy is working with Tracy Modlin on the Lake Garnett Poster display for July and August.

There being no further business, Wanda adjourned the meeting at 5:00 p.m.
