A. Opening of the Meeting

At 6:30 p.m. Dennis T. called the meeting to order.

B. Communications:

Members interested in new charities for the Fall show will have to research and make a recommendation in Nov. for approval in December. The summer show will be the last week in July and will be in conjunction with the North Castle PBA. If members want to allocate a small portion of the funds to another charity it must be researched, presented and approved.

Dennis T. indicated that 2019 membership fees are due. Dennis indicated that our new members Victor S. and Haroshi S. have already paid. Rich Morgante collected dues. Please bring your membership fee to the next meeting or mail it in.

Frank Carollo, chair of the By-Laws Committee has resigned. Art Templeton has joined the group. The committee is looking for additional members. A review of Mr. Camporeale's By-law requested amendment was not worked on this last month. The committee will address this in the future.

The By-Laws committee consists of Steve Rosario Chairperson, Dennis Pennino, Dennis Tedesco, and Art Templeton. Dennis has asked for volunteers for this committee.

The web committee chaired by Dennis P. needs new members. The page needs to be reviewed and redesigned if necessary. Contact Dennis T. if interested.

Discussion on Car Show

It was agreed that the car show was a success but a number of problems were addressed. While the venue was pretty, the management of the Factoria did not contribute to its success. Major problems: late food, non-reduced cost menu, no fast food service i.e. bar-be-cue and the refusal to collect our garbage or use bathrooms.

*Since it's our first show with the Factoria **we all** need to understand what the expectations are from the Factoria and us. General consensus is WCC lived up to its expectations.*

John K. chair of the show indicated that it was a 1000 percent improvement. The overall judging was accurate and overall a improvement over the summer show. Many O. did a great job judging. Jeff and Charlie did an outstanding job judging over 40 cars. John K. helped them judge; they needed more help!

It was agreed that the 12 corvette categories with signs worked well. A sign for “modified corvettes” is needed. In the future only “modified corvettes” will be the 13th class. Non-Corvettes will all be grouped by year, i.e. 50’s,, 60’s 70’s. There will not be a “Modified Non- Corvette Class”. Signs will indicate clearly where the “non-corvettes” will park.

A lengthy discussion about how to categorize modified cars was made. How to determine what makes a car modified. What are modifications? These items will be finalized at the show committee. It was agreed only “corvettes “ will be in the modified class.

Jeff B. and Eric C. indicated that they would make WCC signs and stands. Vince Q. thanked CVCC and Jim V. for the use of the signs

Members suggested we seek another venue for next year’s fall car show. Dennis T. asked the membership to seek out additional charities for the next year.

Curry Scarsdale is very supportive and greatly appreciated. They contribute a max of \$2500 for both shows.

Club Shirts: Another order for new shirts is going out soon. E-mail Dennis. The current club shirt color is the red With the Logo on the left side.


Sizes are:
