## Start the year off with a Daniel Fast!

As Bible Methodists we are challenged to join in a 21 day fast, January 7 to 28. This is called a Daniel fast because of the example set by Daniel. “At that time I, Daniel, mourned for three weeks. <sup>3</sup> I ate no choice food; no meat or wine touched my lips; and I used no lotions at all until the three weeks were over. . . .” (Daniel 10:2-3) Ask the Lord what He would have you to fast during the next three weeks—not as a means of *earning* God’s favor and notice, but as a means of *surrender*! Read Daniel 9 and pray the prayers Daniel prayed for his people, inserting your own name and the name of our church into these prayers! During this first week of the Fast, focus your prayers on revival—in your own heart and in our church! Ask God to give our evangelist for next weekend the messages we need to hear!
