We are currently open for 10:00 Sunday School and the 11:00 am worship service.

Our services will continue to be available for you online or on DVD as before.

The safety guidelines below are intended to minimize the risk of virus spread for those who would like to attend services in person:

- 1. Before attending, please check your temperature at home. If you are not feeling well, have any cold symptoms, or have a fever, please stay home to rest and view the online service.
- 2. In alignment with the latest CDC and NC guidelines, mask wearing is now voluntary. It is recommended that those who have not been fully vaccinated continue to wear a mask that covers the mouth and nose while inside the building, but that will be at their own discretion. Any adult that works with children in a classroom (that are not their own) should wear a mask while in the room with them.
- 3. The worship service will be shortened to approximately 40 to 45 minutes.
- 4. We will provide hand sanitizers.
- 5. Seating will provide a minimum of 6 ft of social distancing between families. In the sanctuary, please do not sit where colored ribbon is placed on the pews.
- 6. An offering plate will be in the foyer at the back of the church for tithes and offerings to be given as you enter or leave the sanctuary.
- 7. We ask everyone to respect the social distance of others and refrain from shaking hands.
- 8. The nursery and children's church will not be available at this time. Parents will either need to keep children with them, or at their discretion one parent may choose to use one of the Sunday School rooms for instruction of their children.
- 9. The restrooms will be available.
- 10. No hardcopy of the bulletin will be distributed.
- 11. The Invitation may also be modified to maintain social distancing. The pastor will provide instructions at that point in the service.
