The City of Cisco received official notice from TCEQ that we are no longer in violation for mcl of Trihalomethanes. The official document reads: “This letter is to inform you that a review of Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) records concerning the above-referenced enforcement matter indicates that the City of Cisco has fulfilled the requirements of the Agreed Order effective on August 10, 2015. Specifically, the City of Cisco has fulfilled the technical requirements and has paid the administrative penalty assessed in the Agreed Order. Based upon this, we conclude that your response has been satisfactory and no further action is necessary at this time with respect to this enforcement matter. The Order will remain on the compliance history for this regulated entity for five years from the effective date of the Order.”
