RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY - EMINENT DOMAIN

WHEREAS, the City of Summerset is a municipal corporation organized under the laws of the State of South Dakota; and

WHEREAS, the City possesses the power of eminent domain to be exercised in accordance with the South Dakota Constitution and applicable statutes, SDCL 21-35-1, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, there is certain real property located within the municipal boundaries of the City of Summerset with a legal description as follows:

A tract of land located in the unplatted portion of the NW1/4 and in Lot 24R of Block 7 of Summerset Subdivision, all of the NW1/4 of Section 31, Township 3 North, Range 7 East of the BHM, Meade County, South Dakota and described as Community Parking and Fire Truck Turnaround, as shown on the plat of Revised Lot 24R, Lots 25 Thru 36, Drainage Lot and Community Pet Park of Block 7 of Summerset Subdivision as recorded in plat book 21 page 341 in the Register of Deeds office of Meade County, South Dakota as shown on Exhibit A attached here to and by reference made a part hereof.

WHEREAS, the City deems it necessary to exercise the power of eminent domain and to acquire ownership of the above described property for use as a roadway; and

WHEREAS, the current owner American West Communities, Inc.; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City deems it necessary to commence the eminent domain/condemnation process concerning the above referenced property for the purposes of acquiring the same in connection with the City's obligation to manage and maintain health, safety, and welfare of its residents; and BE IT RESOLVED that the City determines the above described property does not have a fair market value and that the City will proceed with the eminent domain process to include a determination of the just compensation to be provided to the land owner, if any.
