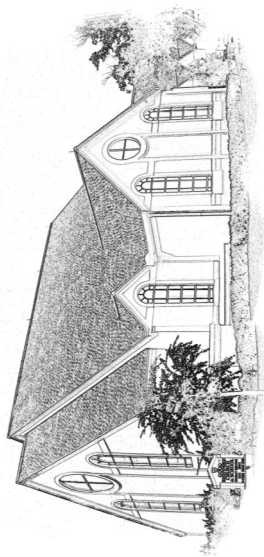

## Good Shepherd Memorial Garden 400 Seabrook Road Tequesta, FL 33469

### Purpose

The purpose of the Memorial Garden is to provide for church members and their families who choose cremation a place on our church grounds for the interment of their cremated ashes. The area will consist of niches for one or two urns and will have a bronze plaque giving the name(s) of the deceased and the dates of birth and death.

### Cremation:

Cremation is consistent with the Christian view that the physical body disintegrates and that God gives a new spiritual body to us. Cremation is a reverent method for the disposition of our earthly remains and is acceptable to the Episcopal Church.

### Procedure

Upon receipt of a written application (form available herein or at church office), together with payment of the specified cost, a niche will be assigned to the Purchaser and a Memorial Garden Purchase Certificate specifying the purchase will be given to the Purchaser. The certificate issued when a reservation is made will outline the agreement between the church and the Purchaser(s).

At the time of death, and by agreement between the family and the Church of the Good Shepherd, interment will take place with the clergy of the parish officiating. The memorial plaque will be provided at the time of interment or as soon as possible after interment. Such plaque will be affixed to the outside of the niche.

### Eligibility for Interment

Those eligible for interment in the Good Shepherd Memorial Garden are members of the Church of the Good Shepherd, their spouses, children or stepchildren, parents or stepparents. It is part of the agreement that no one other than the Church of the Good Shepherd shall have any property rights to any part of the Memorial Garden.

### Financial Considerations

The cost for the use of the Memorial Garden (please see Memorial Garden Price List) is payable upon completion and signing of the Application. The price includes the cost of the niche as well as the urn and bronze plaque showing name, date of birth and date of death of one person's cremated remains. It also provides for the cost of maintenance of the Church of the Good Shepherd Memorial Garden. Urns and plaques for a second interment are additional in cost as specified on the Memorial Garden Price List and Application. The Church of the Good Shepherd provides urns and plaques and only these may be used.

All financial responsibilities with respect to the Memorial Garden are to be met prior to use.

### Terms and Conditions

The Terms and Conditions for use and management of the Memorial Garden are maintained in the church office and are available to any person interested in purchasing a niche. A copy of the Terms and Conditions will be given to all purchasers.
