

Town of Baldwin, Maine SELECTMEN MEETING MINUTES TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 19, 2019, 6:30 P.M.

Attendance: Selectmen: Dwight Warren, Jim Dolloff and Gerry Brown as well as members of the Public.

1. Selectmen Meeting was called to order approximately at 6:32 PM by Dwight Warren.

2. Review/ Approve meeting minutes

Jim Dolloff requested a motion to accept and approve November 5th, 2019 meeting minutes. Gerry Brown seconded the motion; Selectmen voted 3-0 to approve meeting minutes.

3. Review/ Approve warrant

Jim Dolloff requested a motion to accept and approve November 19, 2019 warrant. Gerry Brown seconded the motion; Selectmen voted 3-0 to approve the warrant.

New Business

- Selling Public Works Truck Selectmen discussed the public works truck that can be put up for sale.
 It's a 1974 C60 Chevrolet Truck. Can no longer get parts for this truck and can't be used. Dwight will write up a description to publish in the Shopping Guide.
- <u>Discuss Anderson Road Status</u> A real estate agent called asking about the status of Anderson road, due to a potential sale on that road. Selectmen discussed with Road commissioner and Anderson road is a town maintained road.
- <u>Baldwin's free speed sign from MaineDOT</u> Baldwin has been awarded a free speed sign from the MaineDOT. The sign will be used for portable speed display. Training is required and more details will be given at a later time. Baldwin will be obtaining the sign in Spring 2020.
- Review prices for building repair. There were two bids received from Adam Charles and Dan's Construction. Both bids were written differently between time and material, but very similar in price. Gerry will call both contractors to discuss availability.
- <u>IT support prices.</u> We have several IT issues and cannot get our IT service technician to return phone calls. Selectmen discussed and decided to call other businesses to see if they are interested and get prices on IT support for the office.
