## **1901 - 1996**

Lillian J. Depping, 94 of Pigeon and formerly of Saginaw, passed away Thursday, April 4 at Scheurer Hospital in Pigeon.

She was born Aug. 29, 1901 in Frankenmuth to the late Ferdinand J. and Margretta (Bernthal) Nuechterlein. She was married to August F. Depping on June 19, 1924 in Saginaw. He preceded her in death on Sept. 24, 1978.
