25-00-15 TURF SPECIAL LAWN FERTILIZER

Turf Special is considered to be our BEST fertilizer. It has two sources of nitrogen, an organic slow-release form for long lasting green and a faster release form for an immediate green. The iron is added to help avoid yellowing. The sulfur is added to help increase root growth and to maintain a dark, rich green color.

20-10-10 ALL PURPOSE FERTILIZER

This is a fast releasing fertilizer that can be used for many purposes.

9-23-30 GARDEN, SOD AND NEW SEED FERTILIZER

An all purpose blend that can be used in gardens or with sod/new seedlings.

A no-phosphorus winterizer.

Used if you have disease issues in your lawn. Strictly a root developer.

21-00-10 FERTILIZER WITH CRABGRASS CONTROL (DIMENSION)

This slow-release nitrogen product is a pre-emergent for the control of crabgrass and annual weeds that will last up to 3 months in the soil. DOES NOT CONTROL BROADLEAF WEEDS!

25-00-14 FERTILIZER WITH TRIMEC (BROADLEAF WEED KILLER)

This slow-release nitrogen fertilizer contains a post-emergent for control of broadleaf weeds.

FEEDING RECOMMENDATIONS:

1) 1ST APPLICATION: The first application is to be applied after your first cutting

*21-00-10 with Dimension (crabgrass pre-emergent) should be applied (as a rule of thumb) around the 15th of May or when the lilacs are starting to bloom

*25-00-15 can be used if you have not had any problems with crabgrass in the past

*Corn Gluten Meal - your first application should be applied now

*Landscaper's Choice: Natural fertilizer can be used at this time

2) 2ND APPLICATION: The second application should be applied between June 15th/July 1st

*25-00-14 with Trimec (should be applied when rain is not expected for at least 48 hours, the product must be absorbed by the leaf of the plant to be effective)

*21-00-10 with Dimension can be used on lawns with extreme crabgrass problems

*25-00-15 to be used on lawns with no weed problem or if you are spraying chemicals separately

3) 3RD APPLICATION: The third application should be applied between the end of August through September 15th.

*25-00-15 slow-releasing nitrogen product

*LANDSCAPER'S CHOICE - natural fertilizer

*Corn Gluten Meal 2nd Application

4) 4TH APPLICATION: This should be applied to the lawn sometime in October before the snow starts to fly. This is considered to be the most important fertilization of the year!

*20-00-10 winterizer, a no-phosphorus fertilizer

Things to do:

*Keep your mower blade sharp (dull blades cause the top of the blade to brown)

*Rake your lawn in the spring before fertilizing (lightly!)

*Seed your lawn in the early spring or from August 15 to September 15

*Alternate mowing pattern

*Mow your lawn at 1 1/2" to 2" height in the spring and fall, 2 1/2" to 3" in the summer

*Add soil sulphur to your lawn to help balance the PH in the soil, this will help keep the deep green color in your lawn longer!

*The best time to aerify your lawn would be in the fall, you can also aerify in the spring but then you bring all of the "weed seeds" up to the top of the soil

*Gypsum is used on dog "urine" spots -Limestone is used under trees that add acidity
