Everyone loves the beauty and innocence of a baby. As an expression of that love, our parish announces an adoption program for young and old alike. On March 7-8 and March 14-15, the members of our parish family will have the opportunity to "spiritually adopt" a child who is newly conceived this month. Not all babies make it to birth. Many are tragically lost to miscarriage or premature birth, and others sadly lose their lives to abortion. These are the babies you are being asked to "adopt" by simply praying for him or her each day. You may "adopt" a child individually or as a family by signing a prayer pledge card that will be available during Masses. It is suggested that you name the child for whom you will be praying.
