## Range Rules for 2025

This is a listing of the major rules and concerns while using the range. You should ALWAYS use common sense when handling firearms.

General	<ol> <li>ONLY active members of Westminster Rod &amp; Gun (and escorted guests) may use this range.</li> <li>Members MUST be properly licensed for any firearm in their possession.</li> <li>NEVER use alcohol or illegal drugs before or while using the firing range.</li> <li>Members and guests MUST sign in and out of the range log book, located under the pavilion.</li> <li>You MUST obey all signs posted on the range.</li> <li>NEVER hold or handle any weapon while anyone is down range.</li> <li>Members are responsible for their guests, who also MUST follow all club and range rules.</li> <li>PLEASE be considerate of our neighbors. Don't make unnecessary noise at unreasonable hours.</li> </ol>
Shooting	<ol> <li>ALWAYS hang up the red range flag(s) when shooting so others know the range is active.</li> <li>ALWAYS ensure your shots end up in the designated impact zone, between the poles.</li> <li>NEVER shoot at the telephone poles that mark the impact zone. NEVER hang targets on the poles.</li> <li>ALWAYS bring your own targets. NEVER shoot at club property (tables, chairs, etc.) or other people's targets without their permission.</li> <li>NEVER shoot at the ground, all targets MUST BE ELEVATED 2+ FEET from the ground.</li> <li>NEVER shoot aerial targets, including trap and skeet.</li> <li>ALWAYS use proper targeting materials, NEVER shoot at glass, electronics or appliances.</li> <li>ALWAYS cleanup when you are done, leave the range looking better than when you arrived.</li> <li>ALWAYS Hang the gate cable across the driveway when using the 100 yard range.</li> </ol>
Commands	<ul> <li>19. When two or more people are shooting; someone MUST be appointed as the range officer and use the commands listed below. In an organized shoot, the range master will use the same commands. <ul> <li>a. Mandatory eye &amp; ear protection</li> <li>b. Load your weapons.</li> <li>c. Weapons on the table.</li> <li>d. Ready on the left.</li> <li>e. Ready on the right.</li> </ul> </li> <li>19. When two or more people are shooting; someone MUST be appointed as the range officer and use the commands.</li> <li>a. Mandatory eye &amp; ear protection</li> <li>b. Load your weapons.</li> <li>c. Weapons on the table.</li> <li>d. Ready on the left.</li> <li>f. Line is safe.</li> <li>f. Keep firearm action open.</li> </ul>
