## Becoming an ATA **State/World Champion**

Are you interested in becoming an ATA State or World Champion? To achieve one of those goals, you have to meet eligibility requirements and you must participate in tournaments.

When you place first, second, or third, you get tournament points in that category of competition (for example, forms, sparring, traditional weapon forms, creative weapon forms, etc.). At the end of the tournament season (which starts with the World Championship in Arkansas), the state champion in a given division (black or color belt) is the competitor in that state who has the most tournament points.

For each division and category of competition, the top 10 black belts from all around the world who have the most tournament points participate in a special competition at the World Championship in Little Rock to see who will be that year's ATA World Champions. It's an honor just to be in the Top 10, but the highest honor is to be a World Champion.
