
The 2019-20 Yearbook is now available for pre-order.

Hot lunch service begins on the first day of school! Here are some important steps to follow if you want your child to eat a school lunch.

- Set up your lunch account with Susan Parolini by 9:00 a.m. Wednesday morning. (\$35/child minimum) Every \$3.50 lunch includes chocolate or plain milk. If your child is bringing lunch from home and would like a milk, please send \$3.50 to set up the milk account. You will be notified by Susan when your account is running low because all meals must be paid for in advance.
- You choose when you want a hot lunch. Teachers will take a daily lunch count in class each morning. If something comes up and you decide you need your child to have a lunch that day, you may call your order in to Leti Castaneda at 584-5218 by <u>8:30</u>.
- 3. Please send a note to your child's teacher (grades preschool 5<sup>th</sup> especially) as we are beginning the year. Sometimes the younger students don't know if they are eating hot lunch or a lunch from home!
