

Extracurricular Classes

Soccer Shots

(Thursdays Week 1 through Week 9)

Using creative and imaginative games, weekly 30 minute sessions focus on basic soccer skills like dribbling, passing, and shooting for children ages 3-6 years. Soccer Shots will expose your child to the fun of soccer and provide the foundation needed to get started in the sport. Cost is \$112.50 for all 9 weeks. Private Piano Lessons

Private piano and voice lessons with Abby Carter are offered for 8 weeks during the summer program. Lessons are available for students ages 4 and older. You may sign up for the full 8 weeks, or only when your child is at camp. Summer lessons are \$25/half hour or \$175 for the full 8 weeks, and may be paid weekly or monthly. Mrs. Carter will set up the day and times of lessons with each teacher.

Private Violin Lessons

Violin lessons are offered by Cheri Drummond for students ages 4 and older. Lessons are \$30 for 30 minutes or \$60 for 60 minute lessons.

Summer 2019 Guidelines

Spaces are limited and priority will be given to children who are enrolled at MA for the 2019-2020 school year during Early Bird Registration (March 1 - 20). Children who enroll during Early Bird Registration and are NOT enrolled at MA for the 2019-2020 school year will be placed on a waiting list until the end of early registration. Children placed on the waiting list will be notified on April 1st about available spaces. **All completed forms must be returned by Monday, April 8th to ensure placement.**

- Camp fees are due every Monday. Late tuition must include a \$10 late fee. You may pay for a few weeks at a time in order to avoid late fees.
- Reserved weeks **may be switched** if desired week is available, and advance notice is approved by Kelly Ott.

If you reserve a week and find that your child cannot attend, payment must still be made.

Montessori Academy may credit your account: only if BOTH of the following conditions have been met:

1. You have notified the office in advance AND
2. There is an extra child on the waiting list who can fill your child’s space.

Primary Summer Fee Schedule
