We have read the story of the Ten Lepers so often throughout our lives that we sometimes take the point of the story for granted. We often focus on the thankfulness of the one leper, in contrast to the nine others who did not return to "give glory to God." It is much easier to condemn the nine rather than understand them. Jesus knew about the ten, where they were and where they went. He knew why they were and who they were. And he healed all of them just the same.

In each of our lives there are moments when we are confronted by the difficult challenges of trying to live our faith and of trying to understand what it means to witness to the kingdom of God in our lives. There are moments when everything around us tells us to keep moving along with the other nine. These are moments when we can be tempted to do just enough to satisfy what's expected of us. These are moments when we are too preoccupied celebrating our own lives to think of anything or anyone else.

All of us who have been touched, cleansed and healed are invited by the Lord to act on our own faith, to turn back, to change direction a little, and be as approachable and welcoming to the outsider as He was.
