






Ezekiel 47:1-12 Any Hope from the Babylonian Exiles



In the ninth year of Zedekiah's reign, on the tenth day of the tenth month,

Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon marched against Jerusalem with his whole army. He

encamped outside the city and built siege works all around it.

By the ninth day of the fourth month the family become so severe that there was no food for the people to eat. Then the city wall was broken through the gate between the two walls near the King's garden, though the Babylonia army surrounding the city. They fled toward the Arabah, the Babylonian army pursued the king and overtook him in the plains of Jericho. All his soldiers were separated from him and scattered, and he was captured. He was taken to the king of Babylon at Riblah, where sentence was pronounced on him. They killed the sons of Zedekiah before his eyes. (2 Kings 25:1-7)





The water flows toward the eastern region and goes down into the Arabah, where it enters the [Dead] Sea. (Ezek. 47:8)


Ezekiel 47:1-12 A River Runs through the Deadest Place





Ezekiel 47:1-12 Sea not only Fresh, but Life-Producing



Ezekiel 47:1-12 Fish, Fishermen, and Fruit-bearing Trees















