Old Business

- Debra Sistrunk reviewed the agreements related to school buses using our neighborhood to drop off children and not as a shortcut. I appears that some of the new school buses from the new charter school are using Creekside and Coronado Hills Drive as a shortcut to Cameron Road.
- Catherine Wusterhausen and David Risher participated in the neighborhood cleanup along with neighbors from Old Town.
- Debra Sistrunk indicated that it appears that there are questions on whether a Valero service station will be built along the 290 access road.
- There were discussions related to the proposed zoning change to the property currently being used as a mobile home park along 290. The Neighborhood Contact Team reported that a majority of the responses to the Contact Team's vote opposed the proposed change, and that the Contact Team would therefore oppose the change. The next step will be for the proposed change to go before the Planning Commission; this is currently scheduled for May 28.
